### Principal's Message

Last week our school took part in Orange Shirt Day, or National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. We have recognized Orange Shirt Day for the past several years as a school, but this year was a little different as we had much more intentionality in discussing the topic and learning about it in the classrooms, leading up to this day. The discovered unmarked graves of residential school children last spring was certainly a wake-up call for us as a country to have an honest look at the situation and I believe give some more urgency to our role in recognizing Truth and Reconciliation.

Considering that the Bible is a continuous story of reconciliation and as principal of a Christian school, I've asked the question many times, "As Christians, what is our role in the reconciliation of our country?". I believe our role is to be honest with ourselves and each other, and to work together to bring healing to this nation. It starts with true and accurate education to inform us of the truth, followed by action to make amends and reconcile.

I appreciate the work of the teachers and students in looking through the history, the truth, and what we can do to move forward and play our part in God's story as He looks to redeem and reconcile everyone to Him and His ways. Our work is far from complete, but we as a school will continue to work through these issues and educate our students accordingly. I pray that God will reveal opportunities for us as a school and as individuals to move His kingdom forward in this matter.

### School Wide News:

#### School Messenger

We will continue this year to use the phone, email and text messaging service called **SchoolMessenger**. PHSD schools and the division uses this to contact parents and staff quickly and efficiently. SchoolMessenger will be especially important when we need to communicate regarding emergency situations or other important updates.

Extra service: How to sign up for text messaging

- First, ensure that your child's school has your cell number on file.
- Parents can sign up by texting "Y" or "Yes" to **978338**. *Standard Text Message & Data rates may apply.*

While we strongly encourage parents to participate, the text messaging service is entirely optional. Parents can OPT-OUT at any time by replying "STOP" to any message.

#### School Engage (New)

Our school division is using an online system called SchoolEngage to collect and process student enrolment information and annual demographic updates. All families **are required to fill out forms online** through your PowerSchool account.

In Sept. the SchoolEngage form was sent out to each student's parent/guardian. The Student Demographic Update shows all the information we have in our system. Please review, make corrections and changes if needed, and submit the form.
