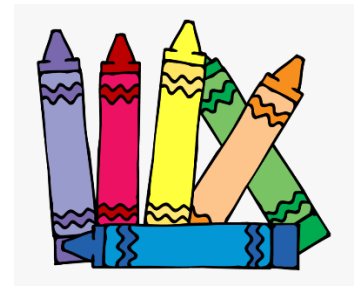


Grade 1H Supply List

Dear Parents of Kindergarten students,

Below you will find a list of supplies each student will need for Grade 1. Supplies need to be brought to school on the first day (Aug 30) so that we can get started right away! Please label all books and supplies with your child's name.

- 6 – duotangs (Hilroy report covers) yellow, light blue, purple, green, red, black
- 10 - 8 1/2 x 11 plastic sheet protectors
- 1 – Hilroy **half plain, half interlined** notebook, 72 pgs. (9 1/8” x 7 1/8”), no coils please
- 1 - Hilroy 1” binder, blue
- 1 – 10pk. **Crayola** original thick washable markers
- 4 – **Expo low odor, fine tip** dry erase marker, blue
- 1 – 24pk. **Staedtler** coloured pencils (pre-sharpened)
- 1 – 16pk. **Crayola** wax crayons
- 6 – Staedtler HB#2 pencils
- 1 – **fine** tip Sharpie, black
- 1 – **ultra fine** tip Sharpie, black
- 2 – Staedtler white erasers
- 1 – pencil sharpener with container
- 1 – scissors, Fiskars 5” blunt tip
- 4 – UHU or Elmer’s 40g (large!) **purple, dry clear** glue sticks
- 2 – large Ziploc bags (10 1/2” x 11”)
- 2 - small Ziploc bags (4 1/4 “ x 4 1/4 “)
- 2 – plastic pencil boxes (different colours) (8.5”x5.5”x2.5”approx.)
 - a - 2 pencils, eraser, scissors, glue stick, 1 expo marker, Sharpies
 - b - wax crayons, markers, pencil crayons
- Maxell stereo headphones
- Indoor running shoes (non-marking)
- Paint shirt
- 1 – sheet personalized student labels
- 1 - small package of 64 baby wipes
- 1 – small pkg. plastic spoons **OR** plastic forks
- 1 – kanga pouch (available for purchase at the school if you do not already have one)
- 1 – water bottle (with spout/straw please, no turn-off lids)
