

Principal's Message

Last year I wrote about the work our teachers and students did at the end of September to recognize Truth and Reconciliation week in Canada and Orange Shirt Day. I'm going to write about it again this year because it's important work and we are far from done. I have had people ask me, "how long do we need to work through this stuff?" and my answer is simply, "if it took decades or centuries to get into this mess, it's likely going to take decades or centuries to get out of this mess."

I was fortunate enough to be part of the Christian School Leaders Conference in Winnipeg last week. The theme or title of the conference was "At the Table". A main portion of the conference was going through the Canadian Museum for Human Rights, then working through scriptures and Jesus' teachings to see what the Bible has to say about who we as Christians have allowed or not allowed at the table. Although Christians have not always been on the right side of history with different groups, especially the Indigenous people in Canada, we can be on the right side of history moving forward. TRC Commissioner Murray Sinclair (Ojibway) stated that "education is the key to reconciliation," adding, "education got us into this mess, and education will get us out of this mess".

As a Christian school, it's an honour to acknowledge our role in reconciliation and educate ourselves so that this never happens again. May we follow the example of Christ and be comfortable with everyone at the table - it's His table, after all.
