TRANSPORTATION FORMS

PHSD BOARD NEWS

2023-2024 Operating Budget Approved

At the May 24th meeting, Acting Secretary-Treasurer Gordon Majeran presented the upcoming school year budget. The Board adopted the 2023-2024 Operating Budget with revenues of \$68.1 million and expenses of \$69.3 million. By the end of August 2024, the division's deficit is projected to be \$1.15 million (1.66% of budgeted expenses) and will be covered by school and board reserves.

Highlights from the budget:

 Increase in Transportation funding of approximately \$700,000

Board Approves 2023-2026 Education Plan

Director of Education Services, Raime Drake, presented the Three-Year Education Plan for 2023-2026. The following priorities will remain, with refined and newly created strategies to support:

- Student-Staff Relationships Positive relationships between students and staff are the foundation upon which we build students' resilience, confidence and mental well-being.
- Literacy and Numeracy Literacy and Numeracy are critical for Student Achievement in all areas of the curriculum.
- Support for Staff (Collaborative Structures/Culture) A
 collaborative environment enables staff to teach a
 diverse student population through purposeful
 inclusion and supports the implementation of effective
 practices.
