I enjoy camping, gardening, biking, traveling, family time, and playing games. Chocolate of any kind is my weakness and I think coffee tastes awful.

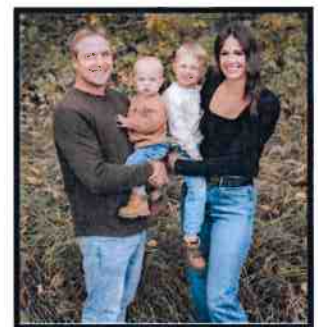
